

Whitehall's S.A.F.E. Station Program



The Whitehall Division of Fire has implemented a S.A.F.E. (Stop Addiction For Everyone) Station Program as a component of project Whitehall's Help for Overdoses (WHO). This program is intended to address the immediate needs of those members of our community that are in crisis relative to an opioid or other substance addiction.

THE PROCESS

STEP 01

Walk In

Members of the public can simply arrive at the fire station and asked to be helped in their fight against addiction

STEP 02

Intake Screening

Fire Division personnel will complete an intake screening to determine the type and amount of substance(s) abused, vital signs, brief mental health screening, brief medical history, and basic demographic information that will be utilized to refer the client to the correct treatment

STEP 03

Warm Hand Off

The Fire Division will coordinate a warm hand off between Division personnel and a recovery or treatment specialist by transporting the client directly to the detox or treatment facility

NOTE
Law Enforcement will not be contacted unless the person seeking help brandishes a dangerous weapon or displays aggressive demeanor

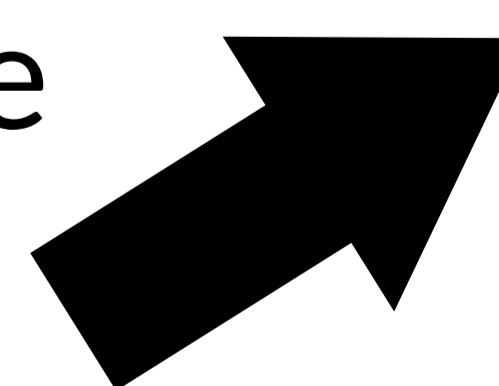
